Greater North America includes the Bahamas, Bermuda, Canada, the Caribbean, Central America, Île Clipperton, K alaallit Nunaat (Greenland), México, Saint-Pierre-et-Miquelon, the Turks an d Caicos Islands, and the United States of America.</p>
<p>Continental North America covers an area of about 24,709,000 square kil ometers (9,540,000 square miles), representing approximately 16.5% of the Earth& #39;s land area and 4.8% of its total surface area. It is the third-largest cont inent by size after Asia and Africa, and the fourth-largest continent by populat ion after Asia, Africa, and Europe. As of 2013 , North America's population was estimated at nearly 579 million people in 23 independent states, or about 7. 5% of the world's population. In human geography and in the English-speaking world outside the United States, particularly in Canada, the terms "North America" and "North American" are typically defined as including just Canada and the United States.[7][8][9][10][11]</p>
