In 2005, Garris created and produced an original anthology television series of 3 , É one-hour movies, written and directed by many of the "masters," which was originally broadcast in the U.S. on the Showtime 3 , É cable network. In several international territories, the films were released theatrically.</p><p>The series debuted to excellent reviews in the U.S. on 3 , É October 28, 2005, with the premiere episode "Incident On and Off a Mountain Road," co-written and directed by Don Coscarelli, 3 , É based on the short story by Joe R. Lansdale. New episodes premiered every Friday at 10 p.m. EST throughout the 3 , É series#39; two seasons.
